Our annual Holiday show is back! Come join us and help us celebrate this special Holidays season. We are planning on having 2 shows if we have enough interest so that we can include everyone. If we have the two shows, they will be on the same day with a break in between. The number of the shows will be determined after the closing of entries.

Please fill in the forms and read all the rules carefully. You must be a PFSC club member(Home Club or 2nd Club) to participate in the Opening Number and Groups (except those in skating school). Solos are for PFSC home club members only. There are guidelines for the soloist selections. If we have the two shows, because of the limited ice time, some soloists may be selected to do both shows; some may alternate between the two shows. The selection on the soloists will be done by a panel of board members who are not related to any skaters. The decisions on who will be on both shows will be decided by our show directors.

We do encourage skaters to participate not only in the opening/closing number, but also in a small group. Certain group numbers which performed at the ISI Worlds this year will be selected as a part of the show(s). Those groups will be selected by our Show Directors. If you are not a part of those groups, you may pick your own partner(s) and it must be approved by our Show Directors by the first week of show rehearsals. Please check with them on your choice and the length of the music. Small groups are responsible for their own coach's fees, practice times and their own costumes.

Spots for solos and groups are not guaranteed. We will try our best to include everyone. Selections will be posted by the end of the first week of November.
